



works beautifully to guide the trainer (and the dog!) through the process of developing rock-solid impulse control, instinctive recognition of and responses to cues and behaviors even under heavy distraction, and teaching creative, independent thinking and problem solving skills in a fun, but highly structured, way. It also allows the dog and trainer / handler to create their own system of communication and to help them bond deeply through the process of learning together.

While they're written for performance athletes, not for Assistance Dogs, although the ***Control Unleashed: (The Puppy Program)*** time) is solidly add to the "MUST HAVE" category of Assistance Dog training resources. The *Puppy Program* is designed to instill a life-long love of learning, focus and working aptitude while creating a dog who's handler focused, solid and




stable in any situation and able to perform reliably and confidently no matter the degree of distraction or the circumstance. It's designed to prevent issues long before they begin.


coordinator before implementing their training strategies if it differs to what our training team as suggested / recommended.


